About the Scholarship

The City of Whiting Scholarship was instituted in 2009 as the result of a partnership among elected Whiting officials, the BP Foundation, the Whiting Community Improvement Fund, Lake Park Development, and the Whiting-Robertsdale Community Improvement Corporation. The Scholarship is funded through private donations and donations from the City of Whiting. The BP Whiting Refinery and the Family of Ron Plewniak continue to contribute annually to the fund.

The Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who are the legal dependents of residents who own and occupy a home in Whiting.

Original awards were for \$2,000 per school year. The 2024 award will be \$6,250 per year with a four (4) year total award of \$25,000. A 1099 tax form may be issued by the college or university if the combined total of all financial assistance received by the student exceeds the IRS threshold. For the 2024 Scholarship, up to four (4) scholarships may be awarded (including the Plewniak Engineering scholarship described below).

For the 2024 graduates, a restricted scholarship opportunity has been established by the Plewniak Family. The Ronald F. Plewniak Scholarship has been endowed for an eligible applicant who is pursuing a degree in Computer Science, Mathematics, Engineering or Technology (from ACT-Defined STEM majors in these categories). The 2024 award will be \$6,250 for each year in a STEM major, with a four (4) year total award of \$25,000. Ron Graduated from Whiting High School in 1965 and then obtained an Electrical Engineering degree from Purdue University, West Lafayette. He worked his entire career at Inland Steel and was highly respected as the go-to guy to solve complex problems. The goal of Ron and his family with this scholarship is to help a Whiting resident get a good start on a rewarding career.

Scholarship Conditions

To maintain eligibility, students must demonstrate that they are classified by the institution they attend as full-time and must maintain a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) GPA. In addition, winners of the Plewniak Scholarship award must maintain a STEM major. Students are required to submit their grades to the City of Whiting Clerk-Treasurer's Office at the end of each academic year and are to openly communicate any changes in their scholastic involvement. Plewniak recipients will also be required to provide proof of major from the school with the transcript submittal. If a student fails to meet any of the outlined conditions, the Scholarship may be terminated at the discretion of the Committee. The Committee may also consider exemptions to these conditions if extraordinary circumstances warrant it.

Qualifications

To be considered for the City of Whiting Scholarship, applicants must:

- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Sign a publicity release form
