**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITING, INDIANA**

The Common Council of the City of Whiting met in special session on Tuesday, July 20, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. with Mayor Spebar presiding.

I. ROLL CALL

Mayor Spebar, Councilmembers Michko, Michniewicz, Sarvanidis, Turpin, and Zubeck were present, constituting a quorum. Also, present, were Attorney Sejna and Clerk-Treasurer Haynes.

Mayor Spebar read the Notice of Publication sent to the Times on July 14, 2021 regarding the special meeting of the Common Council on July 20, 2021.

The agenda is as follows:

1. Approval of accounts payable vouchers.
2. Any other matters to come before the Council with suspension of rules.

The meeting will be held in the conference room at Whiting City Hall, 1443-119th Street, Whiting, Indiana.

II. ACCOUNTS PAYABLE VOUCHERS

Clerk-Treasurer Haynes presented Civil City Check #500-501E, 13449-13450, 16452-13480, & 13482-13516 in the amount of \$139,037.42. Councilmember Michniewicz moved to approve the Accounts Payable Voucher Checks as submitted. Councilmember Turpin seconded the motion. Roll Call: (Voice) All Councilmembers voted aye. Motion carried unanimously.

III. OTHER MATTERS

Councilmember Sarvanidis made a motion to suspend the rules to consider Ordinance No. CC-2021-2049 for possible 2nd and 3rd reading. Councilmember Michko seconded the motion. Roll Call: (Voice) All Councilmembers voted aye. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Sarvanidis presented Ordinance No. CC-2021-2049 to the Council and stated how it was introduced at the July 6, 2021 Common Council meeting for the 1st reading. The ordinance is to regulate the use of golf carts and recreational off-road vehicles on public property in the City of Whiting. There have been no changes to Ordinance No. CC-2021-2049 since the last meeting.

Councilmember Sarvanidis made a motion to take Ordinance No. CC-2021-2049 to a 2nd reading. Councilmember Michniewicz seconded the motion. Roll Call: (Voice) Councilmember

Zubeck abstained from the vote while all other Councilmembers voted aye. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Sarvanidis read Ordinance No. CC-2021-2049 in title only;


AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF GOLF CARTS AND
